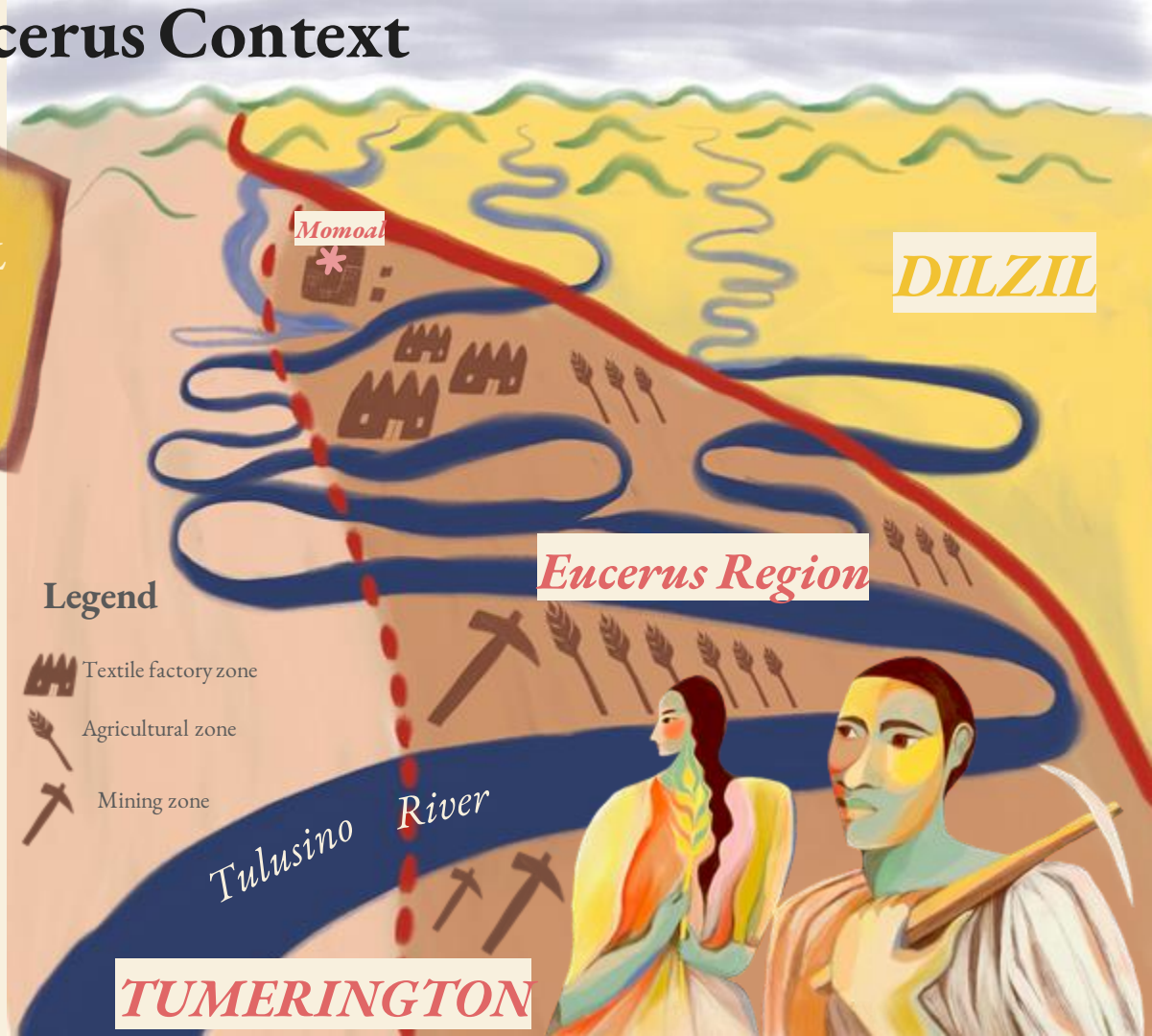
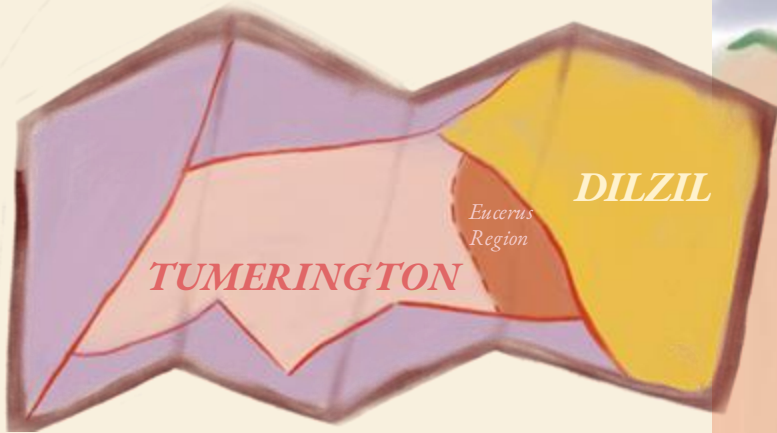

10% work in textile manufacturing



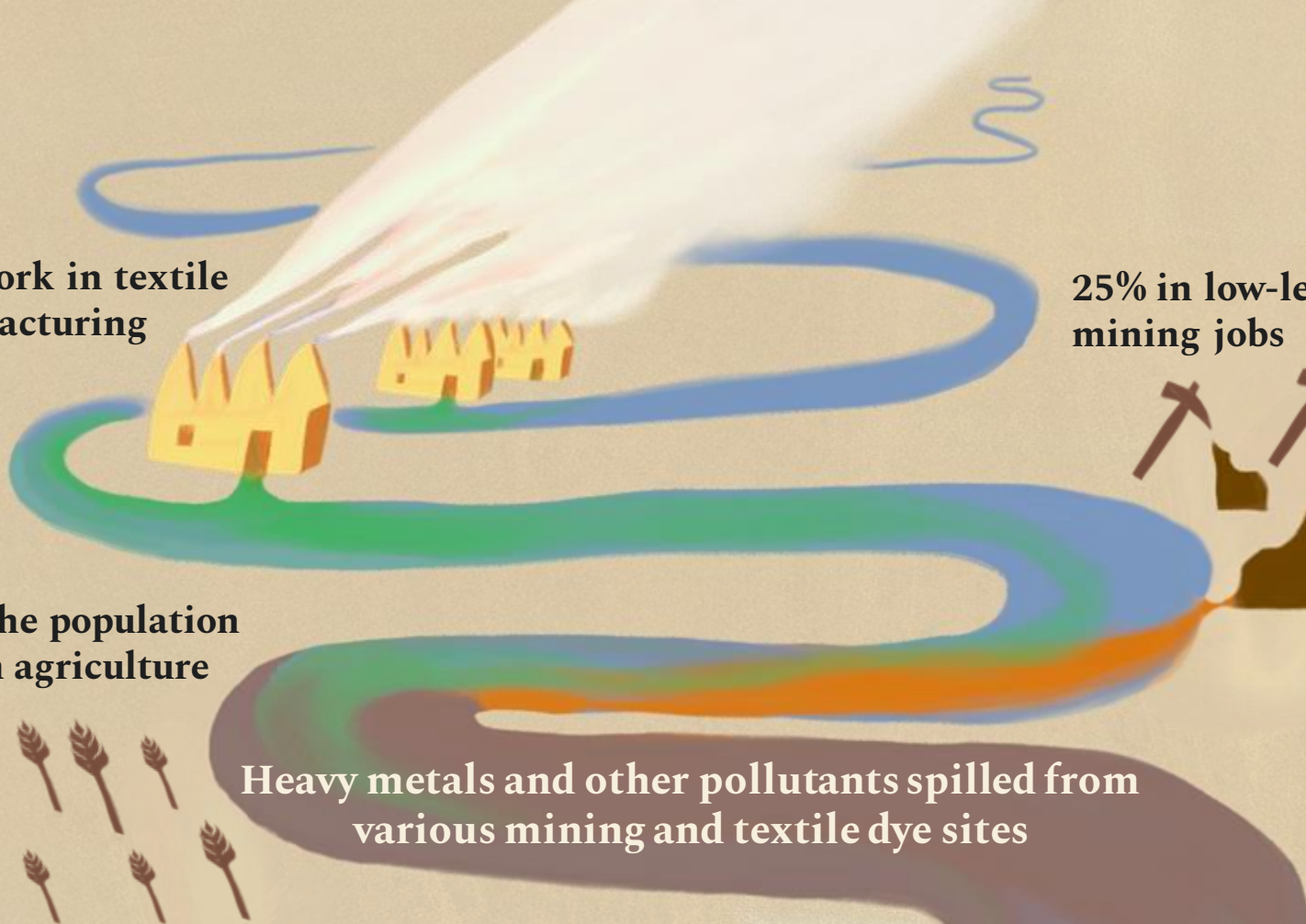
25% in low-level mining jobs



50% of the population works in agriculture



Heavy metals and other pollutants spilled from various mining and textile dye sites



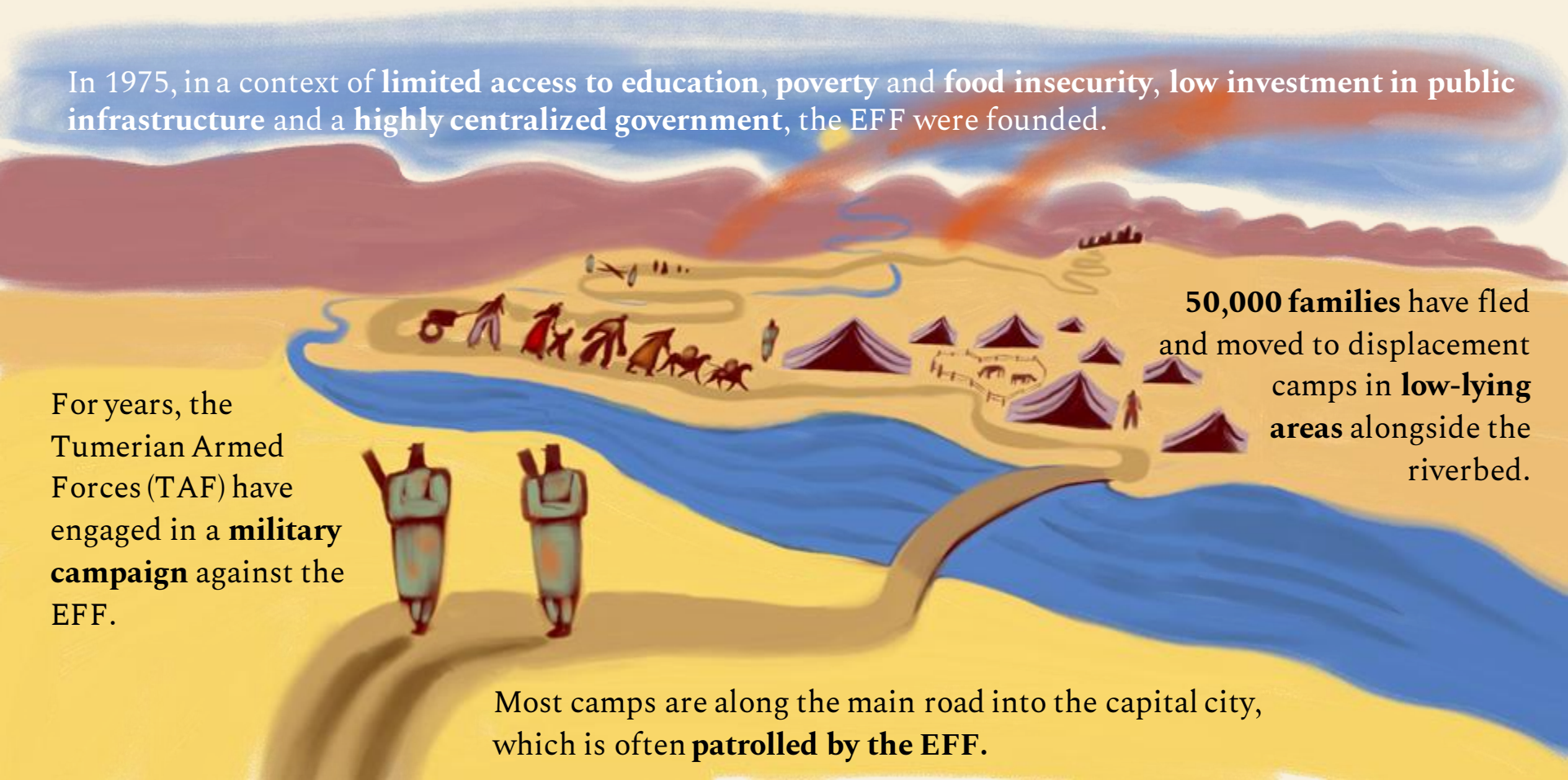
The rise of the Eucerian Freedom Fighters (EFF) & conflict in the region

In 1975, in a context of **limited access to education, poverty and food insecurity, low investment in public infrastructure** and a **highly centralized government**, the EFF were founded.

For years, the Tumerian Armed Forces (TAF) have engaged in a **military campaign** against the EFF.

50,000 families have fled and moved to displacement camps in **low-lying areas** alongside the riverbed.

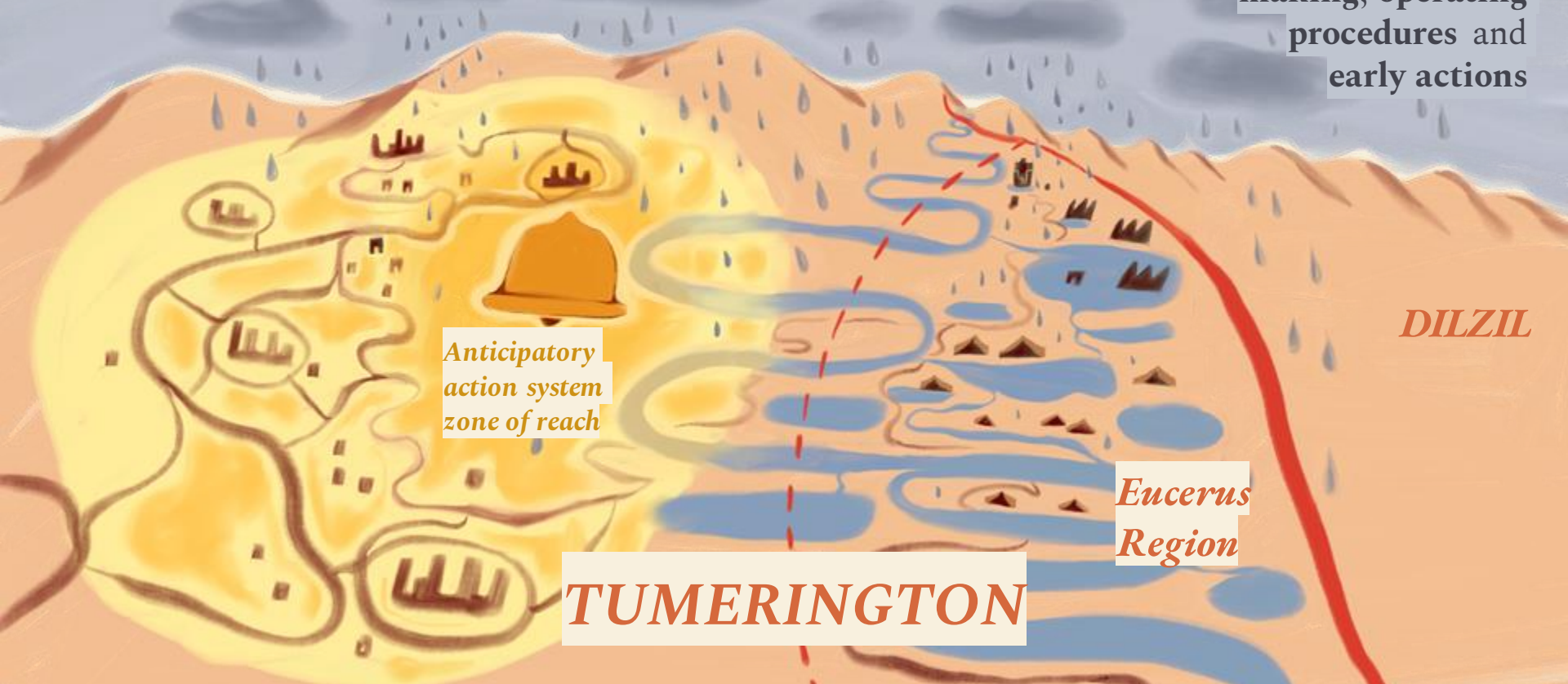
Most camps are along the main road into the capital city, which is often **patrolled by the EFF**.

Same trigger, tailored decision-making, operating procedures and early actions



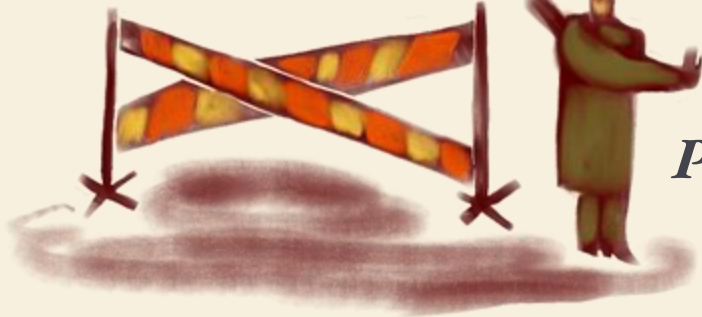

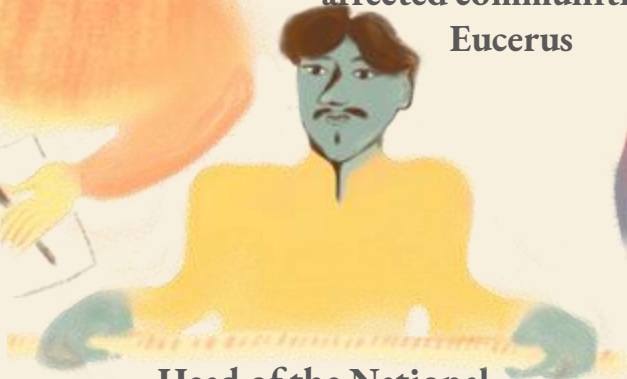
